RV Space: \$20 per night space fee

Stall Fees: \$20 per day Saturday or Sunday. \$35 for both days

Bedding: No bedding will be provided. Exhibitors must provide their own stall bedding.

Class Entry Fee: \$30 per class for halter classes (required double show).
\$15 per class for each performance class. Exhibitors may choose to enter either or both Gold and Silver shows.
\$15 per class for youth classes (required double show).

Advertising: Business card ads are available in the show program for \$15. Ads will be black and white and must be camera ready.

Entry Deadlines: April 16, 2008. Mail postmarked after this date may not be in the show program.

Health Requirements: State law requires those crossing state lines to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. Show personnel will not check health papers.

Security: Night security will be provided Friday and Saturday. All llamas must leave the fairgrounds Sunday night.

Arrival and Departure: HALTER ANIMALS may arrive Friday evening or Saturday morning. The Gray Gate will be locked from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM on Saturday. PERFORMANCE ANIMALS may arrive Saturday evening after 6:00 PM or Sunday morning. The Gray Gate will be locked from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Sunday. To avoid paying to reenter the grounds you must carry a pass that will be in your registration packet. There will be a parking fee collected at the gate.

ALSA Fees: All animals participating in the show must pay a \$10 ALSA fee. This will cover both shows. Any person entering animals must be an ALSA member or pay a \$60 non-ALSA member fee in addition to the \$10 per animal fee. Please list your ALSA membership number on your entry application.
