

## SHOW RULES

### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Performance Classes: Public Relations, Obstacle, Pack

Novice: Open to animals who have never entered an Advanced class or earned no more than 3 ribbons in either First, Second or Third place in an Open or Novice Division.

Advanced: Open to animals that have placed First, Second or Third in Open or Novice division or deemed capable of competing at the advanced level by its owner.

Youth Classes: Showmanship, Public Relations, Obstacle, Pack. See Part Q, Llama and Alpaca Youth Program pages 109 thru 118 of the ALSA Handbook 14th Edition and addenda on the ALSA website.

Junior: 8 yrs. through 11 yrs.

Intermediate: 12 yrs. through 14 yrs.

Senior: 15 yrs. through 18 yrs.

Age divisions may be combined if there are fewer than 8 total entries in any two of the age divisions.

Halter Classes:

#### Wool Divisions:

Suri Wool: Fleece hangs and drapes over the body forming a natural part along the spine. Fibers are grouped into a distinctive and well-defined lock structure. The fiber has absence of crimp and minimal loft.

Light Wool: Minimal body wool, short neck wool and smooth legs.

Medium Wool: Moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool.

Heavy Wool: Abundant body and neck wool, minimal to abundant leg wool, (leg wool to knee and hock)

#### Age Divisions:

Juvenile: 5 months - 12 months

Yearling: 13 months - 24 months

Two Year Old: 25 months - 36 months

Adult: 37 months and older

If the animal's birthday falls on the date of the show, the animal shows in the next age division. If there are less than three entries in a Suri age division, the age divisions may be combined. Male and female divisions will not be combined.

Produce of Dam: Entry includes two offspring by the same dam. Each must be show in their appropriate halter class. If the dam is not owned by the exhibitor, written consent from the dam owner must be mailed with the entries. The entry must be made in the name of the person who owns the dam.

Get of Sire: Entry includes three offspring by the same sire out of at least two different dams. Each get must show in their appropriate halter class. If the exhibitor does not own the sire, a written consent from the sire owner must be mailed with the entry. The entry must be made in the name of the person who owns the sire.
