

Western States Llama Futurity

April 26th, 2008, State Fairgrounds, Salem, Oregon
Judge: Darrel Anderson

Judging criteria for this event will follow the Llama Futurity Association guidelines: Conformation and Movement – 60%, Fiber – 20%, and Overall Appeal – 20%. (See LFA web site (www.TheLFA.org) for detailed explanation of categories.) Entry fees and sponsor donations after expenses will be paid out as premiums. There will be trophies for class winners and ribbons awarded to 5th place.

Futurity Rules:

- 1. The sire does not have to be nominated in order for an offspring to be entered in the futurity. Nomination fee is \$100 for first sire nominated and \$50 for each additional sire nominated by the same ranch. Owners of a sire or the person nominating a sire will receive 20% of the premium won. If the sire is not nominated, Western States Futurity is considered the nominator and 20% of the premium is retained by the futurity.**
- 2. CLASSES:**
 - Class 1 – males 5-15 months Silky/traditional**
 - Class 2 -- females 5-15 months Silky/traditional**
 - Class 3 -- males 15-24 months Silky/traditional**
 - Class 4 – females 15-24 months Silky/traditional**
 - Class 5 – males 5-15 months Suri**
 - Class 6 – females 5-15 months Suri**
 - Class 7 – males 15-24 months Suri**
 - Class 8 – females 15-24 months Suri**
 - Class 9 – Herd Sire Nomination**
- 3. The suri classes will include animals with the four lock structures defined on the Suri Llama Association. Go to the SLA website www.surillama.com for details.**
- 4. Classes may be combined if a small number of entries is received or to equalize the entries in each class. Suri classes will not be combined with silky/traditional classes.**
- 5. Llamas will enter the ring in order of age, oldest first, so the judge can evaluate them by relative age.**
- 6. Entry in the ALSA show is not a requirement.**
- 7. Stalling Requirements. See Western States Llama Futurity entry form.**
- 8. All class winners are asked to have their photos taken under the banner. Photos will accompany a write up in llama magazines.**
- 9. To be included in the Program, enter by March 31st, 2008. Late entries will be accepted until one hour after end of AgFest Halter show on April 26th, 2008.**
